### Helpful Hints

-Blends have an I in them. The I stands with another consonant. These are the I-Blends: bl, cl, fl, gl, pl, sl. - R-blends are consonant blends that include the letter r. There are seven r-blends: br cr dr fr gr pr tr -In single-syllable words that end in the letter *s*, *f* or *z*, the ending consonant is usually doubled. An easy way to remember the rule is to make up an acronym (e.g., San Francisco Zoo).

-When there are two or more of an item or thing, it is called a *plural*.
