## Helpful Hints

- Blends have an l in them. The l stands with another consonant. These are the l-Blends: bl, cl, fl, gl, pl, sl.
- R-blends are consonant blends that include the letter r. There are seven r-blends: br cr dr fr gr pr tr
- In single-syllable words that end in the letter s, f or z, the ending consonant is usually doubled.
- An easy way to remember the rule is to make up an acronym (e.g., San Francisco Zoo).
- When there are two or more of an item or thing, it is called a *plural*.
