

WEBSTER COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM 2021-22 Guidance for Back-to-School

Face masks are required for all students, staff, and visitors in the school building. Masks are required on all school busses, but not required for outside school functions.



Masks will be required on all school busses in accordance with the US Department of Transportation and CDC mandate. Buses will maintain assigned seating and be sanitized twice daily.



All meals will be served in the classroom with safe physical distancing.



Protocols for positive cases and contact tracing will continue in accordance with GaDPH and CDC guidelines.



Masks will be used inside the classrooms to help our teachers and students stay safe from COVID-19.



Air Purifying Systems are located in each classroom to help cut down on airborne germs and viruses.

Cleaning in the school will take place before, during, and after the instructional day.



Temperatures of students and staff will be taken upon entry into the building. Please help monitor your child's symptoms.



One refillable water bottle will be provided to each student by a local business (to be prefilled at home with water only). Water is also available in the cafeteria at the school's 2 new bottle filling stations and in the office (as needed).



Hand sanitizing stations and hand washing stations are available throughout all facilities. Hand sanitizer will be available at the front of each bus.
