Theme: Farm & Names

This week will consist of the theme focused on farms and our names. We will continue to focus on the letter: F and number: 6 this week. We will discuss farm vocabulary words. We will learn about and identify farm animals. We will discuss planting/growing items on farms. We will read farm themed books. We will have whole group and small groups. Music and movement will consist of singing and dancing to theme related songs. We will attend music class on Wednesday! We will learn about the life cycle of a pumpkin, the resources needed to grow a pumpkin, and the difference between a living and nonliving pumpkin. We will use watercolor paints to create a name and art activity. We will create a farm and name themed art activity. We will work on the following literacy skills: letter identification and letter sounds. We will work on the following math skills: counting, quantifying, and number identification. We will strengthen our fine motor skills by writing our names, letters, numbers, and working in our journals.
