The **DeKalb County Diploma Completion Program** provides adults with the opportunity to earn a fully accredited high school diploma in a flexible and supportive environment designed to meet the needs of adult learners.

Program Overview

- **Accreditation:** Fully accredited program
 - **Eligibility Age:** 22 years or older
 - **Residency:** Open to both in-district and out-of-district residents

Program Schedule & Flexibility

The program is designed to offer learning opportunities comparable in length to a traditional public school academic year, while allowing flexibility for adult learners.

- **Proposed Daily Schedule:** 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM as an example, students may chose what hours of the day work best for them
 - Students may attend year-round (12 months)
 - 24 hour access 7 days a week
 - Coursework can be completed at an individualized pace as long as due dates are adhered to

Enrollment Requirements

To enroll in the program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Demonstrate a minimum **5th grade reading level**
 - Have earned enough credits to be considered at least a **10th-grade student**
 - Provide **proof of age**
 - Provide **proof of residency**
 - Verify they are **not currently enrolled in another school**
 - Submit a **copy of their high school transcript**
 - Complete all required **district enrollment forms**
