Description	<p>Did you know that 1 in 8 students in Michigan high school students identifies as lesbian, gay, bisexual, and/or transgender (LGBT) and they are at greater risk for homelessness, substance use, harassment, suicide, as well as school failure and dropout? The good news is there are simple, impactful steps schools can take to mitigate these risk factors.
