Requirements

- Scholarship Application
 - Can be found on the website under Guidance Department; Scholarships
- College Letter of Acceptance
- Two community letters of recommendation
- Two teacher checklists *use forms in packet
- Transcript

- Additional Requirements
 - Complete a FAFSA
 - SAT/ACT scores
 - GPA of 2.5
- Personal Statement

The last SAT test date for Local Scholarships is March 9th
The last ACT test date for Local Scholarships is February 10th

Initial applications are due to the CPC by March 3rd

College Applications Process

- Submit applications ASAP
 - All colleges have different deadlines
 - Request an unofficial transcript
 - May need a Letter of Recommendation
 - Must fill out a Senior Brag Google Form a week in advance prior to deadline
- Check your college's requirements for SAT/ACT test scores.

- Immunizations
 - Required form
 - May have to get shots
- Proof of Residence
 - Driver's license
 - Student ID
- Send a final official high school transcript.
 - After graduation
 - Must let CPC know where to send it
