Your Grad Nite is this WEDNESDAY, May 18

Here is the information that you need:

1. Seniors need to be in the student parking lot, lined up at the number on the sidewalk that corresponds to your bus number, at 5:30 am. WE ARE LEAVING AS SOON AS THE BUSES ARE FILLED, SO IF YOU ARE NOT HERE AT 5:30 am, YOU MAY MISS THE BUS. There will be security in the parking lot all night to make sure the cars are safe from vandalism.
2. The dress code for the trip is the same as for Pioneer Valley with one exception AND WILL BE ENFORCED. This means no tank tops, camisoles, shirts showing midriff, Daisey Dukes, or jeans with excessive holes. No t-shirts, sweatshirts, or hats with school logo or professional sports logo (Disney additional rule). If you wear anything that is not in dress code, you will be asked to change. If you do not, you will not board the bus.
3. NO FOOD OR DRINKS CAN BE BROUGHT ON THE BUS. We will provide food and water for you.
4. No bottles with liquid in it that is bigger than 1 oz... for example, eye drops, small hand sanitizer, and perfume samples are okay, full bottles of perfume and large hand sanitizers are not.
5. You must have your PVHS ID to board the bus. This is a district rule, and you will also need it at Disneyland.
6. All prescription and OTC medicine must be in the original bottle. Prescriptions must be brought in by your chaperone and given to you after they have been checked at the gate.
7. No backpacks are allowed inside Disneyland. You can take one with your pillow and blanket in and stuff for the bus - but it must be left on the bus. You will be riding the same bus back that you ride down. Purses are allowed but must be no bigger than 8"x11" (a piece of notebook paper).
8. There will be search dogs at the gate at Disneyland. These are cannabis sniffing dogs, and they are very on-point. If there is any cannabis smell or residue on clothing, in pockets, or anywhere on your person, they will hit on it. Also, any purses and phone cases you take into Disneyland will be searched by Disney Police as we enter the park. If you are detained for any reason in Disneyland, you will become the ward of the Disney Police, and PVHS will not be able to help you. As much as we love you, we will only be able to wave as they take you to Disney jail.
9. As you leave the bus in Disneyland, we will give you a wristband and a ticket. If you lose either, you will have wasted \$260 and will need to call your parents to come pick you up - because there is not a way to get another one as in years' past.
10. We will board the buses to leave Disneyland at 2:00 am - and you will have until 2:15 to get back on the bus. This is a Disney rule, that we have one half hour after the park closes to get the bus loaded and leave the parking lot.
