Course Description: This course is designed to give students an in depth study of reading and literary elements.

Course Outline: This course will cover both fiction and nonfiction stories, the study of literary elements, the recitation and study of poetry, Using the Bible as literature, and the study of *The Hobbit, The Diary of Anne Frank* and *The Hatchet*. Students will also study world parts throughout the Semester.

Method of Instruction: Notes and Lecture will be the primary source of information. Worksheets and projects will be included. Oral communication and participation in class along with independent reading will be required. Grades are taken daily so attendance is a MUST for course completion.

Student Responsibilities: Daily attendance, keeping up with materials, class participation.

Attendance: Good attendance and class participation are a must in order to succeed in this course. It is each student's responsibility to find out what assignments are missed during an absence and to make plans with your teacher on how to complete those assignments in a timely fashion (including tests, quizzes, writings, and labs).
