Our 24-25 school year kicked off on Monday, and we hit the ground running!

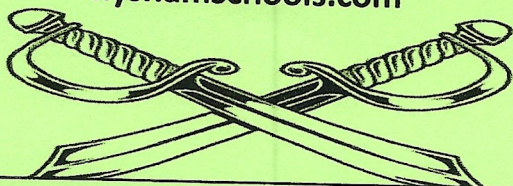
The staff spent three PIR days prior to the first week going over handbooks, expectations, and standards and preparing their rooms for students.
