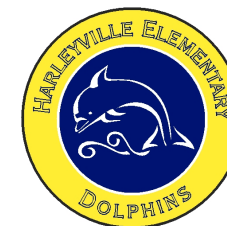

- ⇒ At least 50% of third graders will score meets or exceeds on math on SC Ready by 2023.
