- I. A Public Hearing to approve a proposed property tax increase for Stark County Community Unit School District #100 for 2022 will be held on December 19, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. at 300 Van Buren, Wyoming, IL 61491. Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing district may contact Mr. Brett M. Elliott, Superintendent, 300 Van Buren, Wyoming, IL 61491; Telephone (309) 695-6123.
- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended for the year 2021 were \$6,106,014. The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$6,410,806. This represents a 4.74% increase over the previous year.
- III. The property taxes extended for debt service for 2021 were \$1,047,430. The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service for 2022 are \$1,046,000. This represents a decrease of .14% from the previous year.
- IV. The total property taxes extended for 2021 were \$7,153,443. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$7,456,806. This represents a 4.07% increase from the previous year.
