Event Guidelines and Participant Expectations:

- Inform ALL members and guests in your group about these tailgating expectations.
- Tailgating sites (in the designated areas) are chosen on a first come/first serve basis upon arrival to the event. We will limit this event to 25 alumni classes.
- All participants must enter through the gate with a game ticket.
- **Only 4 vehicles** are allowed to come into the tailgate area. This includes bringing in grills, coolers, etc. No dropping off and coming back out will be allowed.
- Propane and charcoal grills are the only permissible sources of heat for cooking. Burned coals and/or residue from cooking may not be permitted to make contact with the paved surface of the parking lot or on the grass. All areas must be cleaned of all debris at the conclusion of the event.
- No sales activities or solicitation are allowed in any area.
- While we would like for you to enjoy the tailgating experience, we ask that you make sure all visitors to your area maintain orderly conduct during the tailgating events. We expect all guests to maintain orderly conduct.
- Only designated areas may be used for tailgating.
- Set-up may not begin prior to the end of all school day activities. **(3:30 pm – 7:30 pm set up time)**. No one will be allowed to drive in the back of the school after 7:30 pm. All vehicles must be parked in parking lots.
- Tents or canopies must be secured and may not obstruct sidewalks, drive lanes or pedestrian walkways. Anchors may not be inserted in the parking lot or other hard surfaces.
- Individuals, groups, and organizations hosting or participating in tailgate parties are responsible for their own conduct and are expected to respect the rights of others.
- Music played during tailgating must be played at a level that does not disrupt other tailgate parties. Explicit language is prohibited. Amplified music (including DJs and bands) is prohibited.
- Individuals or groups engaging in inappropriate or disruptive behavior will be directed by law enforcement personnel to cease and desist from doing so and/or will be removed from the premises.
- Grills must be tended to at all times.
- Hot coals must be properly disposed of by tailgaters. **NO DUMPING ON SIDEWALKS!**
- Please bring trash bags to properly dispose of trash from your designated area.
- Areas must be cleaned and vacated by 11:00 pm, no exceptions.
- Failure to follow these rules and regulations may result in removal from campus and possible additional actions by school personnel and/or law enforcement.
- No refunds of any fees will be given.

Alcohol and tobacco use on all school properties is strictly prohibited. Violators shall be asked to leave the facilities immediately and could possibly face charges from law enforcement. No refunds will be given.
