Each completed entry will be worth 10pts.</p> <p>The journal entries do not have to be longer than five sentences. They should be made each time the student reads in order to record reactions to the text while their thoughts are fresh.</p> <p>Please write in paragraphs rather than bulleted lists. Locate two critical reviews on each book. Obtain print sources from a public library or online sources from Alabama Virtual Library--www.avl.lib.al.us/. Just click on “Student Resources” at the top of the AVL home page. Next, click on “High School” and thread your way to the Gale and EBSCO icons. <u>If you</u> have difficulty finding any articles, just ask any librarian to assist you. Copy or print your articles. 2. As you read your articles, underline the author’s main points. 3.
