AGREEMENT dated this 1st day of September, 2024, between the Ventnor Board of Education, in the County of Atlantic and the State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "SENDING DISTRICT"), and the BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SPECIAL SERVICES SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE VOCATIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, in the County of Atlantic and the State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "RECEIVING DISTRICT").

WITNESSETH

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- The SENDING DISTRICT agrees to purchase educational services from the RECEIVING DISTRICT. The RECEIVING DISTRICT agrees to provide educational services to the SENDING DISTRICT in accordance with the applicable New Jersey Statutes and the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education. The specific educational services to be purchased and provided are described in 1a, below.
