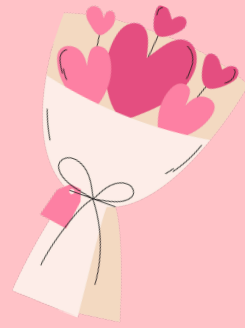

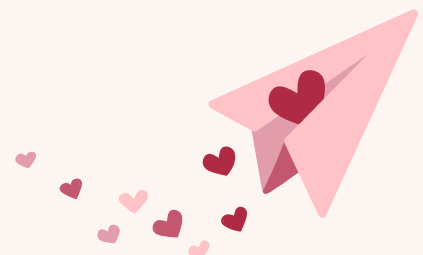
FROM MS. JARAMILLO

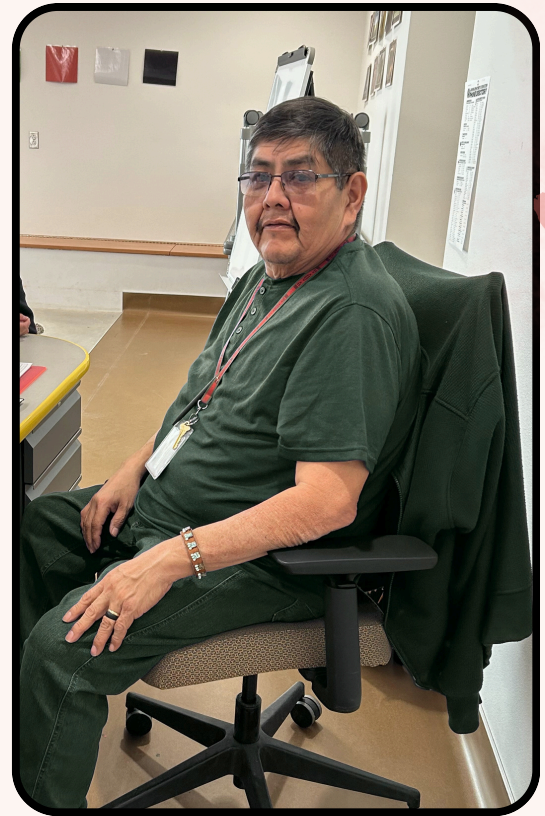
