The District will continue to follow previously established social, emotional, and mental health monitoring and support services. All District faculty and staff have been trained to identify social, emotional, academic, mental health and nutritional needs of students and school personnel. GASD has initiated processes to have all HVAC systems assessed and evaluated for improved ventilation.
e. <u>Contact tracing</u> in combination with <u>isolation</u> and <u>quarantine</u> , in collaboration with the State and local health departments;	The school nurses and administration will conduct contact tracing and reporting in accordance and in cooperation with Pennsylvania Department of Health.
f. <u>Diagnostic</u> and screening testing;	<p>The District will continue to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • encourage parents, students and staff to complete daily wellness checks; and • refer applicable individuals to community-based COVID-19 testing centers.
g. Efforts to provide <u>vaccinations to school communities</u> ;	The District will continue to be willing to serve as a vaccination site for the community as needed. The District will provide a link to vaccination and site availability information on the district website at www.greenville.k12.pa.us
h. Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies; and	District personnel will address the needs of individual students on a case-by-case basis while adhering to established Special Education policies and procedures
i. Coordination with state and local health officials.	District personnel will maintain open lines of communication with local health officials and comply with all orders issued by the Pennsylvania Secretaries of Health and Education.


