The committee discussed using netting in lieu of a backstop as has been witnessed at other schools.

The committee decided to let Mr. Zehr know that the field can be farmed this summer, if possible.

Concrete work at BGS was discussed. Miller & Son is coming first of June. Hoerr will also be coming in the beginning of June to get started.

Discussion was held about where buses can be parked. Keach will be on campus this week to review possible options for where to put an area for buses to be parked.

The parking lot at the athletic facility is to be crack filled and resurfaced this summer, after the track project.

The BGS white rock will soon be removed and replaced with mulch. The white rock removal will start this week.
