Opportunity for High School Credit Algebra I

CCMS offers an opportunity for students to participate in an accelerated math program. Students in this program will take the high school credit course Honors Algebra I during their 8th grade school year.

Students qualify for this program through their math performance while in seventh grade. Seventh graders who earn a math grade of 90% or higher for their Semester 1 average and also earn a 90% or higher for their 3rd quarter math grade will be invited to take the Iowa Algebra Aptitude placement test. This test, along with their performance on the math portion of the state's TCAP Assessment, will determine their math placement for eighth grade.

If a student qualifies for placement into the high school credit Algebra I course, parents will be informed and given the opportunity to accept or decline that placement.
