The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Steve Stanley, Chair; Lewis DeWeese; and Bobby Bearden. Sandra Mercier, Vice-Chair, and Terry Bramlett were absent.

The meeting was called to order by Steve Stanley, Chair.

Art Hubbard, Assistant Superintendent, presented the Board with updates on the construction projects. Mr. Hubbard stated the Fannin County High School Guidance Suite is complete.

Mr. Hubbard stated the Fannin County High School New Clinic demolition is complete; the framing is complete; and the electrical rough is complete. The completion date on the clinic is expected on or before January 15, 2015.

Mr. Hubbard gave an update on the East Fannin Elementary School Roof project. The ballast has been removed, and the Kindergarten wing is complete. The “old” wing will be completed by January 1, 2015.

Mark Henson, Superintendent, reviewed the agenda for the meeting on Thursday, December 11, 2014.
