IMPORATANT INFORMATION

- We ask that you kindly read the **Parent Communication Packets** that come out weekly on either Thursdays or Fridays. You get it sent to you through our Option C one call system directly to your email and you can **ALWAYS** find it on the St. Anne's website under the parent tab. In that packet you will always find information and events that you need to know.
- **ALL** absences **MUST** be reported by **8:45 a.m.** Even if you contact the teacher, you must contact the office as well. For your convenience, the telephone messaging service **answers 24-7**. If the absence is not reported to the office by 8:45 a.m. your child will be marked for "Parent Neglect "on Option C.
- If you have **any changes** to dismissal, such as car rider, bus rider, walker, or Extended Care, from what your child was told in the morning, please call the Main Office by 2:25 p.m. Once dismissal begins, the telephone will not be answered until dismissal is over. If your child knows where he/she is going for dismissal you do not need to contact the office.
- If your son or daughter needs to leave for any appointment there are 2 steps, let the teacher know and please let the Main Office know at the **BEGINNING** of the day. That way your child can be ready to go when you arrive.
- If your child is experiencing symptoms of illness at home, please **DO NOT** send them to school. It saves the parent/guardian the hassle of having to come pick them up and it also keeps other students/teachers safe and healthy. It is a school policy that if your child has had a fever or thrown up in 24 hours they **must** stay home. If we find out that is not the case, they will be asked to go home. Again, resulting in the parent/guardian having to pick them up so it's easier to keep the child home. If your child is out for 3 or more consecutive days, they will need a doctor's note upon returning.
- These above items are meant for the health and safety of your child and others. We want to maintain a sound academic environment as well. Thank you for your attention regarding these matters.

My name is Coach Sammy Barona, and I'm the head coach of the Junior High Boys Basketball Program here at Bethlehem Catholic High School. As we approach the start of the season, I wanted to reach out to all 7th and 8th grade boys enrolled in a catholic school who are interested in playing basketball this year.

The purpose of this email is to inform you of the dates and times of the Junior High tryout. We, at Bethlehem Catholic, want to extend the opportunity for your students to participate with our program. Students who are in 7th or 8th grade and attending a catholic school, are eligible to try out.

The first day of Junior High tryouts will be held at Bethlehem Catholic High School gymnasium on Friday, November 15th from 7:30-9:30pm. There will be 3 days of tryouts with subsequent cuts after practice on Day 3. The schedule for Friday, November 15th - Sunday, November 17th is listed below:

Day 1 - Friday, November 15th, 7:30 pm - 9:30 pm

Day 2 - Saturday, November 16th, 2:30 pm - 4:30 pm

Day 3 - Sunday, November 17th, 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm (cuts to follow practice)

I **Strongly Advise and Recommend** that all athletes and/or parents interested in participating check with the Bethlehem Catholic athletic trainers or Athletic Department to ensure that all required documentation has been completed and/or finished properly prior to tryouts. Athletes will not be able to participate **after** the tryouts without having ALL the necessary paperwork completed.
