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CHECK OUT THESE IMPORTANT LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

The 2023 Florida Legislature passed, and Governor Ron DeSantis signed into law multiple House Bills pertaining to student health.

- House Bill 389: menstrual hygiene products
- House Bill 443: how to provide emergency first aid for choking.
- **House Bill 1537**: Headache medication for students.
- House Bill 1421: 80% of school personnel trained in youth mental health awareness.
- House Bill 1069: Provides additional provisions for reproductive health education.

SICK STUDENT GUIDANCE

The beginning of the school year has a tendency to be a time when students end up sick due to exposure to new germs. Below is guidance for when your child is sick:

- Fever: if your child has a temperature over 100.4°F, they need to stay home. Students must be fever free for 24 hours before coming back to school.
- Vomiting or diarrhea: if your child has had vomiting or diarrhea more than 1 time within a 24 hour period, please keep your child home until they are symptom free for 24 hours.
- COVID: If your child has been diagnosed with COVID, they may return to school after 5 days if they are fever free for 24 hours. No additional testing is required.
