Practice At Home

- Read and write together! After your child finishes reading a story, challenge them to add onto their story in writing OR write a retell of the main events. Pay close attention to spelling!
- For math, practice adding and subtracting numbers using a variety of different strategies. These strategies might include decomposing numbers, using a number line, or drawing the base ten form of the numbers to add or subtract, etc.
- Challenge your child to collect data and make graphs to represent their findings. They have learned how to make and read line graphs, bar graphs, and circle graphs.

Spelling: Compound Words

Compound words are two or more words that combine to make a single new word.
