# TENNESSEE FINANCIAL AID

Tennessee students have access to financial aid resources and programs that are exclusive to our state. Among these are the TN Promise, HOPE Scholarship, Aspire Award, and the TN Student Assistance Award - just to name a few!

Most aid requires that you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov

To qualify for the TN Promise, fill out the application at tn.gov/tnpromise and ensure you complete all TN Promise requirements.

# Types of Financial Assistance for College/School

<u>Federal Pell Grant</u> - Qualify based on family income and by completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid (Full Pell Grant is \$7,395 per academic year) This is free money you do not pay back.

<u>Tennessee Student Assistance</u> - If funding is available, all students qualifying for Pell Grant (full or partial) will receive an additional \$2000 per academic year. \$4000 private school

<u>College Scholarships: MTSU Tennessee Tech University UT-Knoxville</u>

<u>Local Scholarships</u> - Students receive applications and notifications in the SCC google classroom and through email. Typically, starting around November/December

# Tennessee Promise Scholarship

- The Tennessee Promise is a financial aid program <u>offering two</u>
   <u>years tuition-free at a 2-year or technical college</u> to
   Tennessee high school graduates.
- Tennessee Promise provides eligible students with a last-dollar scholarship, meaning the scholarship will cover tuition and fees not covered by a Pell grant, the HOPE scholarship, or TSAA.
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student to maintain the TN Promise

## TN PROMISE Program Requirements

In order for students to participate in the program, they must meet several requirements and deadlines for Class of 2025:

- Apply to the Tennessee Promise program at <a href="https://www.tn.gov/collegepays/tsac-student-portal.html">https://www.tn.gov/collegepays/tsac-student-portal.html</a> by November 1
- Attend Mandatory Meeting Tuesday, December 10 @ 10:00 am
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <a href="www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a>
  (Available in December 1, 2024- Completion/Submission date Due by April 15, 2025)

Use 2023 Tax information

- Complete and log online eight (8) community service hours (After November 1 by July 1, 2025)
- Complete Financial Aid Verification through your chosen institution. (by July 15, 2025)
- Must enroll in a community college or TCAT for Fall of the year of graduation

# Tennessee Hope Scholarship

### TO QUALIFY:

- Apply by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), available at www.fafsa.gov. The application will be open beginning in December 2024. Use 2023 Tax Return information
- Graduate from a TN eligible high school.
- Enroll in one of the eligible Tennessee public colleges, universities, or private colleges.
- Entering freshmen must achieve a minimum of a 21 ACT OR minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA).
- Must enroll within 16 months following high school graduation at any eligible postsecondary institution.

# Tennessee Hope Scholarship Award Amounts

Four-Year Institutions and Two-Year Institutions
 with On-campus Housing: \$4,500 per year for
 full-time enrollment as a freshman and
 sophomores; \$5,700 per year for full-time
 enrollment as a junior and senior.

The UT Promise scholarship covers tuition and mandatory fees at any UT school.

Eligibility - To be eligible to receive the UT Promise scholarship, students must have

Family household income under \$75,000 a year

Qualify for the Tennessee HOPE scholarship

Meet all requirements for the TN Promise

Fill out and submit the UT Promise Application by PROMISE

December 15, 2024



Will pay any outstanding mandatory tuition and fees not met by other scholarships. (Not housing or meal plans)

### To be eligible for the Tech Promise

- Have a total adjusted gross income of \$40,000 or less as determined by the FAFSA
- Be accepted to Tennessee Tech University
- Receive the Tennessee Lottery HOPE Scholarship and be eligible for the federal Pell
   Grant
- Be a full-time new freshman

### **CCCHS Scholarship Timeline**

### 2023-2024

<u>September</u> ~ *College application and exploration month in Tennessee* 

*Now is the time to begin submitting admission applications <u>and scholarship applications</u> to those schools. Many Tennessee schools will waive the application fee for the month of September.* 

- Apply for the TN Promise at TNpromise.gov
- · All other scholarship opportunities are posted in the senior Google Classroom.

### October ~

October 1 - College/Technical School Fair

Explore privately funded scholarships

Continue to meet college application and scholarship application deadlines.

### November ~ TN Promise Application Closes Nov. 1

- If you plan to <u>live on campus</u>, make a note of when that application opens & *apply early*.
- Students should check their school email, private email and college portal/email often for important dates and information.

.

<u>December</u>~ FAFSA Opens Dec. 1(or shortly after) and must be submitted by April 15, 2024

- · Complete the FAFSA at FAFSA.gov
- The FAFSA is used to calculate your *Student Aid Index [SAI]*, a measure of your family's annual ability to pay for college.
- · A lower SAI increases your eligibility for need-based financial aid, such as the Federal Pell Grant.
- · Financial Need equals the Cost of Attendance minus the SAI
- Students with a lower SAI qualify for more financial aid.
  - Students with a zero SAI demonstrate full financial need and qualify for more financial aid opportunities to help pay for school.
- Most deadlines for college scholarships and admission occur on or before December 1
- Mandatory TN Promise meeting for seniors at 10:00 a.m. on Dec. 10

# Scholarships continued

January ~ Local scholarship opportunities will be shared with seniors.

FAFSA Frenzy, TBA. (free help completing the FAFSA)

February ~ Local scholarship applications will be due mid-February.

March ~ FAFSA Frenzy, TBA (free help completing the FAFSA)

April 15 ~ FAFSA application deadline for TN Promise eligibility.

# What you can do now

- Apply to colleges/schools Students received an email with free application dates
- Create your FSA ID (student and parent) if you haven't already done so at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch">https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch</a>
- Be sure your Senior reads emails and has joined the Google classroom
- Completing the FAFSA will require 2023 tax returns (automatically uploaded when filling it out) Student portion asks them to put in an email, phone number social security and DOB to invite the parent to fill in their information
- Use a college days to visit campuses (Student need to come to the SCC for paperwork) Each student has three (3) college days
