General Rules and Conditions for SCJUSD Summer School:

- 1. Students are expected to attend the vast majority of the time. If a student has less than 80% attendance rate they will not be allowed to attend field trips.
- 2. All normal school rules and dress code apply.
- 3. Summer School is a privilege we are providing to our school family. It is an extracurricular activity available to all students who attend ECE, grades K-6.
