**Vocabulary Words**- studied, shook, covered, melted, bud, calendar, along, cycle, evaporate

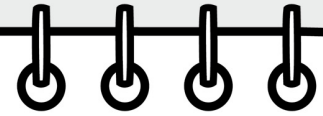
**Writing**-Describing an Object
