A copy of the Notice and Certificate as to same was duly filed in the records of the Board of Education with the minutes of this meeting.

The following members were present: Bryan Honaker, Alison Allen, Nathan Beavin, and Steve Orr.

The Public Hearing was called to order by Bryan Honaker, Board Chairman at 7:00 p.m.

Dr. Mark Martin read the notice published in the Meade County Messenger and explained the rationale for the 2022 tax rate. The rate would generate approximately \$10,681,960.00. The following community members were present; Anna Haas, Donald Haas, and Trey Webb. Mr. Webb and Mrs. Haas spoke in opposition to the 2022 tax rate.
