**MAYDAY MAYDAY!** Springfest is coming! Mark your calendars for May 1, 2022 and see below for Springfest news...

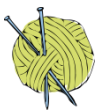
**LENTEN DAY OF SERVICE:** We ask all Parishioners to come out and help at the annual Lenten Day of Service on April 2nd at 9am.

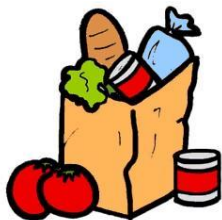


**SVDP MEETING:** The next meeting to be announced at a later date.
