General guidelines for on-campus parking:

- Student parking is for seniors first and possibly only. Students will be assigned a numbered space and must wait for this assignment before you start driving to school. If you are caught parking on school grounds without a designated spot you may face disciplinary actions.
- A parking permit must be displayed on the vehicle. Vehicles without permits will not be allowed to park on school property. The parking lot will be monitored and if cars consistently do not display their tag, parking may be revoked. If there is a change in your initial vehicle, please notify the main office immediately.
- The speed limit on school property is 10 m.p.h.
- Students are not allowed to visit their vehicles during the school day without permission from administration.
- Students must park in their assigned spot. Students may not trade spots with another student or allow another student to use their spot without the permission of the RHHS administration. If this occurs, both students will lose the privilege or the opportunity for this privilege.
- In the event that a student's car is involved in any type of accident while on school property the Rocky Hill Police Department will be notified at the time of the accident.
- According to Connecticut State law effective August 1, 2008, during the first six months the newly licensed driver may not have any passengers in the vehicle except for: a licensed driving instructor giving instruction; or his or her parents or legal guardian, at least one of whom holds a valid driver's license; or one person who is providing instruction and is at least 20 years old, has held a driver's license for four or more consecutive years and whose license has not been suspended during the four years prior to training. During the second six months (month's seven through twelve) the only additional passengers allowed in the vehicle are members of the driver's immediate family.
- Parking is a senior privilege first and extended to eligible juniors if space allows. Failure to comply with any and all of these guidelines may result in loss of parking privileges. Administration reserves the right to revoke parking privileges for disciplinary reasons and/or violation of the Student Code of Conduct.
- School attendance is tied to your privilege. Students can have *no more* than 7 unexcused tardies to school per quarter, otherwise your parking spot will be revoked for that entire semester and assigned to someone else.
