• Gates open at 2:30 p.m.

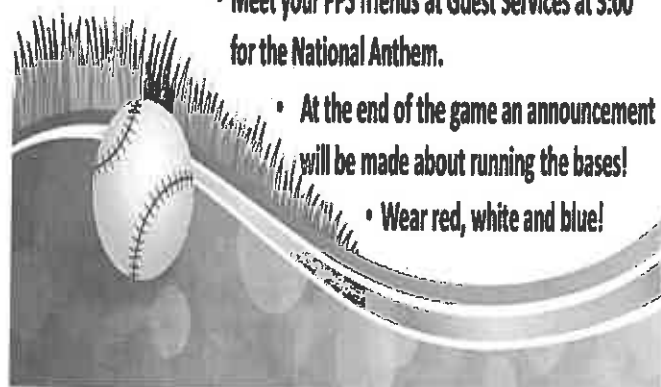
• Game starts at 3:33 p.m.
