A New School Year Is Off To A Great Start & We're Here To Stay!



Panther Cross Country Boys ranked 4th in preseason poll

The boys cross country team has been ranked fourth and fifth in Class 1A, according to two preseason polls from MileSplit Kentucky. The fourth-place ranking for the Panthers was configured by the average and total times of the top 5 Panthers' best 2021 time, the website states. In addition, the fifth-place ranking for DSHS was configured by the average and total times of the top 5 Panthers at the state meet.

The ranking follows a successful 2021 season for the Panther boys. The team clinched the Region 1 title for the third consecutive year and then went on to finish 10th in the state, making history for Dawson Springs. The same team was ranked 7th in the same preseason poll last year.

Returning runners – who are the reasons behind the rankings – are seniors Tyler Hale, Yosiyah McCune and Ethan Osborne, juniors Michael Faughn and Lucas Osborne, and sophomore Sean Stallins. New high-school harriers are senior Keifer Slaton and freshman Stephen Fowler.

The team also includes younger athletes from the middle and elementary schools. Preston Drennan, Tobiyah McCune and Jonathon Morgan comprise the middle school ranks, while Ayden Summers, Noah Keyes and Kye Swatzell will repre-

sent the elementary school.

The 2022 season began on Saturday, August 20th at the Season Opener in Hopkinsville and continues every Saturday through the state meet the last weekend in October. In addition to the team rankings from MileSplit Kentucky, some of the Panthers showed up on the individual rankings. Hale earned 15th in the state due to his season-best time of 17:32.87 at regionals and 23rd in the state due to his time in the 2021 state meet. Lucas Osborne was ranked 27th in season-best times. Ethan Osborne was ranked 45th in season-best times and 50th in state meet times.

In this year's rankings from MileSplit Kentucky, the Panthers follow No. 1-ranked Villa Madonna, then St. Henry District and Bethlehem.

Dawson Springs Girls Cross Country team to focus on rebuilding By Melissa Larimore

During the 2021 season, the Dawson Springs High School girls cross country team had six runners. None of those runners returned for the 2022 season. Four of the girls graduated, and the other two changed schools. Last year's team finished second in the region and competed in the state meet. Although the roster is light right now, the team has its share of fight. Abigail Ward, a senior and a standout basketball player, has joined the team this year.

Also suiting up for cross country is junior Maddie Back, another multi-sport athlete. The two girls are the only high-schoolers on the team. Coming up behind them is a solid list of young runners. The seventh-grade

squad of Audrey McCoy and twins Ashtyn and Baylee Swatzell have already made a mark in cross country. Since McCoy began running for the school in 2018, she has earned 12 medals and helped her team – with the help of the Swatzells – claim many top-three spots at meets. Ashtyn Swatzell hasn't finished a race over 19th place since she

joined the team in 2019. Her sister, Baylee, has finished in the top 10 nine times out of 11.

The team is rounded out by two elementary harriers: Kylie Latham and Hayley Lewis.

Athletic Director Rhonda Simpson said five more girls have signed up to run cross country, but are awaiting sports physicals. The team is coached by Wayne Simpson. The first meet of the season was held on Saturday, August 20th at the Season Opener in Hopkinsville.


