★ OUR LEARNING

Reading- I can make inferences. I can use illustrations and details to describe story events.

Phonics- I can read and write words with short vowels. I can read and write words with digraph -ck and double final consonants. I can read and write words with inflectional ending -s.

Writing: I can my first and last name. I can write a narrative text. I can identify articles and demonstratives.

Math- I can write numbers 1-50. I can add sums within 20, including with word problems. I can measurement objects and compare lengths.

Science/Social Studies- I can discuss Johnny Appleseed.
