HB3 Goals

The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 29% in June of 2025 to 52% by June 2030.

The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 21% in June of 2025 to 53% by June 2030.

The percentage of graduates meeting the CCMR criteria will be maintained at 92% from August 2025 through August 2030.
