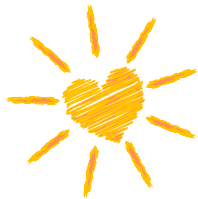

Dear Tri-Township Community,

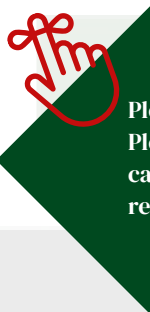
