



Suspected case of Covid-19 in student

If a student is referred to the office, student will be immediately isolated & temperature checked.

If the student's temperature is less than 100.00 & demonstrates no other symptoms (persistent cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, nausea or diarrhea), the student will return to the classroom.

If a student's temperature is 100.00 or higher OR if the student demonstrates other COVID-19 symptoms (persistent cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, nausea or diarrhea), the student will remain isolated and sent home immediately.

Parent or guardian should contact physician for guidance. COVID-19 testing will be encouraged.

Potentially affected rooms will be cleaned and sanitized.

If the student has siblings or others who live in the same home that attend school, siblings must self-isolate at home pending outcome of symptomatic sibling's COVID-19 status.

Student receives results from COVID-19 test.

Student does not take a COVID-19 test.

If student tests negative for COVID-19 student may return to school after symptoms have improved and student has been fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.

If student tests positive for COVID-19, follow confirmed case process.

Student must be out of school until symptoms have improved and they have been fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.

Student MUST provide note from physician stating illness is NOT COVID-19 related and may return to school with a return to school date on it.
