Purpose:

- Support Owosso Public Schools staff members in an innovative environment where students come first by providing grants
- To promote the Owosso Public Schools Foundation while building parent and community awareness and interest in the OPS Foundation

Criteria:

- One application per staff member
- Grants will be available for preschool to 12th grade initiatives
- Looking for programs, events, or materials that support the Foundation's focus on:
 - Health and Wellness
 - Educational Enrichment
 - Career & Technical Education
 - Technology
 - Arts
- Grants may be written for up to \$1,000 (Grants may be partially funded at the discretion of the OPS Foundation.)
- Any new curriculum must be approved by the Owosso Board of Education
- Funds awarded in this cycle must be spent by May 29, 2026

Expectations:

- Spreading the Word: For each grant awarded a flyer would go home with students who benefited, explaining that the OPS Foundation supported the activity. If materials are supported with this money, there will be OPS Foundation labels of acknowledgement for funding merchandise.
- Provide the OPS Foundation a summary of the completed project. (Send to Jessica Thompson.)

Thursday, February 12, 2026: Grant awards will be announced by OPS Foundation President Mike Konopacke.
