(College Prep = Options After HS)
For 4 Year Universities, grades need
to be C- of better

A- History 2 YRS Req.

B- English 4 YRS Req.

C- Math (Alg 1, Geom, Alg 2) 3 YRS Req./4 YRS Rec.

D- Science (Physical & Biological) 2 YRS Req./3 YRS Rec.

E- Language Other Than English 2 YRS Req./3 YRS Rec.

F- Visual and Permorning Arts 1 YR

G- College Prep Elective 1 YR

SAT/ACT Exams are not required for UC/CSU but check with each private and out of state campus to confirm






Main Types:

#### **WORK STUDY**

Federal program that facilitates on campus part-time jobs for students who qualify. A large number of campus jobs are reserved for these students.

Students get paid directly



 Subsidized: Government pays down interest while student is in school

lower than private loans. Two Types:

 Unsubsidized: the student is responsible for interest accrued while in school



**GRANTS** 

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

FREE MONEY based on specific requirements or criteria. Students need to research and apply. Note that each scholarship has its own deadline.




