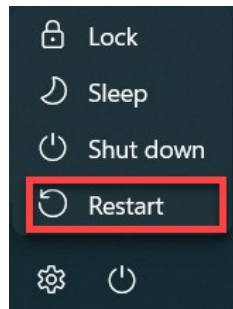


Science Meets Technology

The First Computer Bug Was a Real Bug

The term “computer bug” is now a staple in tech jargon, but did you know it originated from an actual insect? In 1947, Grace Hopper, a pioneer of computer science, found a moth trapped in a relay of the Harvard Mark II Computer. She taped the moth into the logbook with the note: “First actual case of bug being found.” Thus, the term “debugging” was born.

Beware of Holiday Scamming

1. Missed delivery notification scam texts: fraudsters will send fake delivery notification text messages, in hopes that you will click on the link. The link will take to you to a fake website designed to either steal your money or personal information.

2. Social ads promoting fraudulent items: scammers will create ads on social media sites like Facebook and TikTok that link to fake stores or listings. Buyers will end up with a phony or counterfeit item or even their money or identity stolen.

3. Hacking over public Wi-Fi: resist the temptation to use unsecured public Wi-Fi. Scammers have the ability to intercept your data, including credit card numbers, passwords, and personal information. Use a virtual private network (VPN) when using public Wi-Fi to encrypt your data.
