We remain concentrated on utilizing data from our students to drive their instruction and personalize their education through hands-on Montessori lessons. Maintaining strong communication between home and school is essential in our success of providing the educational foundation of our young learners. For the 2022-2023 school year, all students in grades $4K - 2^{nd}$, in regular classrooms, will be involved in Montessori lessons and classes. We want to highlight students for achievements whenever possible and if we do not have permission forms signed, your child's name would not be able to be included in publications. Please remember that carrider drop-off and breakfast is between 7:00 and 7:25 each morning, and carrider pick-up and dismissal is at 2:30. If your child arrives after 7:25 A.M., you must escort them inside and sign them in as tardy. Anyone entering the building must have their ID with them. Please make every effort to get students to school on time as instructional time is valuable. Excessive student tardiness will result in conferences with attendance personnel and administration. Please assist us with ensuring students arrive each day on time as we want students to have ample time to receive breakfast and make it to class before instruction begins.

The instructional day for students will begin at 7:30 a.m. and dismissal will be at 2:30 p.m. No changes in transportation can be taken over the phone. We must have a written note that is signed with your phone number and dated in order to change a child's transportation. This is for safety purposes. Additionally, students who are leaving early must be picked up prior to 2:00 P.M. with proper ID. We are looking forward to an exciting year filled with new learning experiences for our staff and students.
