To complete the

2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®), when it opens on October 1, 2022, you will need:

1. FSA ID FOR STUDENT

Requires Social Security Number (SSN)

No Parent SSN? If student has an SSN and parent does not, contact your counselor or career

coach for guidance.

2. FSA ID FOR ONE PARENT

3. DOCUMENTATION OF INCOME FOR BOTH STUDENT AND PARENT(S)

- Federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- TIP: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. If it is available, the DRT saves time and minimizes errors by pulling your most recent tax return information into the FAFSA application. Look for it in step 5 of the application - Parent Financials.
