

# WHAT WILL I NEED TO FILL OUT THE FAFSA®?



To complete the  
**2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®)**,  
when it opens on **October 1, 2022**, you will need:

1. FSA ID FOR STUDENT
  2. FSA ID FOR ONE PARENT
- } Requires Social Security Number (SSN)
3. DOCUMENTATION OF INCOME FOR BOTH STUDENT AND PARENT(S)
    - Federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
    - Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
    - Records of untaxed income (if applicable)

### No Parent SSN?

(If student has an SSN and parent does not, contact your counselor or career coach for guidance.)

**TIP:** You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the [IRS Data Retrieval Tool](#). If it is available, the DRT saves time and minimizes errors by pulling your most recent tax return information into the FAFSA application. Look for it in step 5 of the application - Parent Financials.
