

Wyoming Area Lady Warriors Basketball Scholarship

Basketball is a sport that can be played on many levels. It can be played freely in the backyard by children just shooting hoops, by adults in the professional ranks, and by every age and ability in between. It is a sport that requires skill, teamwork, and commitment.



The Wyoming Area Lady Warriors Parents Association recognizes the sacrifice, dedication, and hard work required to participate in the sport of basketball during high school. To honor the resolve of these student athletes and the effort required, starting in 2018, the Wyoming Area Lady Warriors Basketball Scholarship will be awarded.

On the court, basketball requires endurance, intelligence, mental toughness, and problem-solving skills. It is these same attributes that are required for the high school student athlete to succeed during the next chapter in their lives.

To assist them in moving forward, this scholarship honors senior members of the WA Lady Warriors Basketball team who have exemplified leadership and scholarship. The applicant must have actively participated as a member of the team for a minimum of three years (one year must be as a senior), be attending a trade or technical school, community college, or 4 year college/university, and have a cumulative GPA(grades 9-12) of at least 85.

CRITERIA: Wyoming Area Lady Warriors Basketball Scholarship

- Applicant must be a graduating senior who has been an active member of the Wyoming Area Girls Basketball team for 4 years (9-12th grade)
- Applicant must be attending a trade or technical school, community college, or 4 year college/university.
- Applicant must have a cumulative GPA(grades 9-12) of at least 85

ESSAY REQUIRED:

Choose one of the topics below and write a solid essay of at least 500 words. Identify the question you are answering in the first line of your essay.

1. Describe what it means to be a good teammate & offer an example of when you acted as a good teammate
2. Describe what the word sportsmanship means to you & offer an example of when you displayed sportsmanship
3. How have the lessons learned on the basketball court impacted your choice to pursue a college education?
4. How has basketball played a role on making you the person/student you are today?
5. Why basketball?

Essays will be scored by independent reviewers outside of the WA community.
