## STUDENTS TOUR CAL POLY UNIVERSITY

27 Migrant program students were able to spend a day at California Polytechnic State University on Tuesday, April 18th. Students listened to an admissions presentation where they learned about A-G requirements and the college application process. They also received a campus tour where they visited the Dream Center, La CASA (Latinx Center for Academic Success and Achievement), and the Baker Center for Science and Math!





# ART FOR MENTAL HEALTH

Students participated in a mental health workshop where they learned about stress, its causes, and how to manage it using creative strategies. Corazón del Pueblo, a Cultural Center for Creative Arts in Santa María, hosted and led students in a hands-on painting activity where students were able to design and paint their own alebrijes and learn about their cultural significance. It was a fun night of mental health, history, and art!



# MATH AND INNOVATION ACADEMY

From February to April, 23 students joined our Math and Innovation Academy. This academy offers more than 30 hours of supplemental math instruction and prominent activities in coding and data modeling. 21 students were eligible for the \$150 stipend and one Righetti High School student, 9th grade Denisse Maldonado-Castro, won the \$250 scholarship! To earn the stipend and scholarship, students must attend all Saturday sessions, complete weekly assignments, and submit a program evaluation. Additionally, students who complete 30 hours earn 2.5 elective credits. Good job Math Academy students!

Migrant Education families came together for the Annual Regional Migrant Parent Conference on Saturday, April 22, where guest speaker, Tony Orozco, spoke about "Positive Discipline" and its importance in creating respectful relationships at home.
