ADMISSION POLICY

At Amite School Center, we recognize and adhere to the belief that God assigns each individual a gender at birth. This gender will be acknowledged in all interactions involving students, faculty, and staff.

Criteria for Admission

To begin the admission process, the parent or guardian and the prospective student must schedule a meeting with Coach Bass.

Families enrolling at Amite School Center must provide the following:

- Registration Fee
- Completed Admission Application
- Completed Tuition Contract
- Payment of Tuition (as per the selected payment plan)
- Copy of the student's transcript, most recent report card, and/or achievement test scores
- Copy of the student's Social Security Card and Birth Certificate
- Mississippi Immunization Record
- Contact information from the previous school for character reference(s)
- Grades, Attendance Records, Discipline Records, and current Class Schedule from the previous school

Additionally, the student must:

- Have academic records from the former school indicating the likelihood of success at Amite School Center.
- Receive a favorable background report from former school officials, including assessments of behavior and conduct.
- Undergo a developmental test if enrolling in Kindergarten (K5) or First Grade.
- If entering grades 2nd through 12th, take an admission test administered by a school official. Final admission will be determined based on past academic records and admission test results.
- Take a placement test, if previously homeschooled, to determine the appropriate grade level.
- Complete and pass a drug test screening process (administered by a licensed medical provider) if enrolling in grades 9-12 and not previously enrolled at Amite School Center the prior year. This screening will be at the parent's expense.

Additional Admission Policies

- All admissions are subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
- Only students who have completed the entire enrollment process can participate in extracurricular activities.
- Amite School Center admits students of any race, color, nationality, or ethnic origin, granting them access to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities available at the school.
- The school does not discriminate based on race, color, nationality, or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies or programs.
