## WIN Time News

WIN (What I Need) News:

After a two-week cycle of targeted math instruction:

- Grade K 84% of students can identify numbers 1 to 10
- Grade 1 82% of students could randomly identify numbers 1 to 120 and score 75% or higher.
- Grade 2 42% of students could add or subtract fluently to 100 and score 75% or higher.
- Grade 3 80% of students could identify the place value of 3 and 4-digit numbers and score 75% or higher.
- Grade 4 83% of students could add or subtract 3 and 4-digit numbers with regrouping and score 75% or higher.
- Grade 5 -50% of students could solve multi-digit multiplication problems and score 75% or

Grade 6 - 60% of students could correctly reduce fractions and score 75% or higher.
