

# COUNSELING ON POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION



## What is it?

Postsecondary education counseling will provide students with an opportunity to learn more about postsecondary settings, programs, requirements, and the skills necessary to be successful in these settings.

## What are examples?

Postsecondary education counseling may include information about universities, community colleges, comprehensive transition programs, trade/technical schools, military, and postsecondary programs for students with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

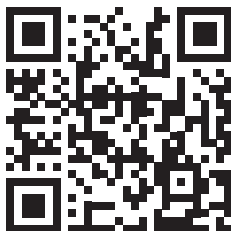


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## College and Career Competency Framework
