## **Homecoming Parade Information**

- 1. Floats may be dropped off at the football field parking lot beginning at 10:30 a.m. Entries MUST be lined up by 12:00 p.m. (NO EXCEPTIONS)! ONLY parade entries will be allowed in the parking lot. NO vehicles will be allowed behind the high school before or after the parade.
- 2. Parade Route: Leave football field parking lot turn left on Pierce Street- turn left on Main Street- turn left on Adams Street (next to old bank)- turn left on Gilmer Street-turn right on Ward Street and reenter football field parking lot.
- 3. At least one adult (21 years of age) is required to ride on each float entry.
- 4. An adult (21 years of age) is required to drive on ALL entries.
- 5. Soft items (t-shirts, hats, plastic footballs, etc.) can be thrown from floats. No candy or other hard items allowed.
- 6. Each parade entry participant **MUST** have a signed permission slip. **The parade entry** sponsor is responsible for collecting and ensuring each participant has a signed form.
- 7. Students riding a school float will walk to the football field parking lot with their teacher at 1:55. Students riding a non-school float may checkout at 1:00 with their group sponsor. Once students checkout, they will not return to the classroom. \*Please see the Homecoming parent information letter for additional information.
- 8. The parade will begin promptly at 2:15 p.m.; all participants must be situated and prepared for the parade at this time.
- 9. No animals, three or four-wheelers, bikes, or go-carts are allowed in the parade. Tractors pulling floats are allowed.
- 10. Parade entry forms **MUST** be submitted to the office no later than **3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 25th.**
- 11. School will be dismissed when the parade ends. Parade entry sponsors are responsible for getting students to their correct dismissal location (i.e. bus, signed out to parent, walker, etc.).
- 12. Parents and guardians are to park in the front of the school, then walk to the football field parking lot if they are picking up their student from a parade entry.
- 13. Above all else, **safety is our number one priority.** Please take all preventative measures and remind students of ways to ensure their safety before, during, and after the parade.
- 14. Grit + Grind will be on campus if you'd like to purchase a refreshment. If students purchase a drink, they need to finish it before getting on their float.
