To register for any of the College in High School opportunities, you will need do the following by the associated deadline:

Step 1: Complete the 2023-24 College in High School Application at <a href="https://francis.tfaforms.net/217843">https://francis.tfaforms.net/217843</a> with your parent/guardian. On this form, you will be asked to:

- Provide student information (name, address, email, etc...)
- Select the course(s) that you would like to enroll
- Sign the University acknowledgements/disclosures
- Provide parental consent

Step 2: Submit payment for the tuition cost. Upon submission of the 2023-24 College in High School Application, you will be asked to submit payment for the total tuition cost through the PayPal Payment system. You do not need a PayPal account to make this payment, you can submit the payment as a guest. You will not be registered in the course(s) until the payment is received.

Upon receipt of your completed application/registration, Saint Francis University will process the application and register you for the appropriate course(s). You will receive a confirmation email welcoming you to the College in High School program within <u>2</u> <u>business days.</u>
