REGULAR BOARD MEETINGS

Regular meetings of the Lincoln-Woodstock Cooperative School Board shall take place on the second and fourth week of every month to be determined at the annual organizational meeting. The date is subject to change when it falls on a holiday or during a school vacation period, or when it conflicts with other important activities of the school board or superintendent.

All regular meetings shall be open to the public and press.

All changes of regular meetings from normal dates shall be advertised at least 24 hours prior to the date of the meeting.

Special meetings shall be held at the call of the Chairperson.

A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum.

The School Board recognizes that the consistent attendance of Board Members at Board Meetings is essential for the efficient, effective operation of the Board's duties as well as fulfilling our individual obligations as elected officials.

Since community involvement in the educational process requires knowledge of that process, it will be the policy of the Board that all facts and information kept or prepared on the activities of the public schools, except confidential information as exempted by law, will be considered public information.

Any citizen may, with supervision, during office hours and subject to such regulations as the Superintendent may prescribe, have access to and inspect the public records of the public schools.

School Board meetings will adjourn no later than 10:00 p.m. Meetings may be extended by a vote of the Board.
