Central High School Parking Regulations 2022-23 School Year

- Cars will be ticketed and/or towed at owners' expense for violation of parking regulations. Parking is a privilege that may be revoked without a refund for parking violations. Vehicles parked within 1000 feet of school property are subject to search.
- 1. Vehicles on campus of Central High School must have a 2021-2022 Central High School hang tag hanging from the rear view mirror and must be in a marked parking space.
- 2. Once a student drives on campus, he/she is considered 'at school' and must check out legally in Student Services to leave campus again.
- Students may not loiter (hang-out) in the parking lot before or after school. Students must exit their vehicles and report to the school building Immediately upon arrival to school.
- 4. For afternoon dismissal all student drivers must turn right out of the parking lot.
- 5. Dream Team spaces are marked with a DT in front of the number. All other parking is first come first serve.
- 6. Any student vehicle parked anywhere on campus other than the student parking lot will likely be TOWED and parking privilege REVOKED!!
- 7. Radios and sound systems must be kept at a volume that cannot be heard outside of the vehicle within 1000 feet of the Central High School Campus.
- 8. Students will not be allowed to go to the student parking lot during the school day to get items left in car.
- 9. Students may not be on your cell phone while driving in student parking lot.
- 10. Students will be allowed to drive to CCA for 3rd/4th periods only and only if the student is in the WBL Program and drives to his/her work immediately after CCA classes. These students must obtain permission from an Assistant Principal at CHS and the Principal at CCA. All other CCA students must ride the bus to and from CCA. Students may not transport other students to the CCA for any reason.
- 11. Students/Parents will not be allowed to park or drop off in the mornings or pick up in the afternoons in the 400 parking lot.
- 12. Permits <u>may not</u> be transferred to other students. Any student who allows someone else to use their hang tag will lose their parking privilege for the remainder of the school year. Parking hang tags cannot be shared!
- 13. Student drivers must complete a Drug Consent Form to be allowed to park on campus.

**NEW STATE LAW requires that CHS report to the DMV any student who accumulates 10 or more unexcused absences in the current school year or in the previous academic year. Driving privileges of those students will be revoked by the DMV and by CHS.

Students must operate their vehicles in a safe and proper manner at all times on ANY Carroll County School Campus

The following are parking privilege information, rules, regulations and procedures.

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS:

- 1. First in school and/or out of school suspension = 1-week parking suspension
- 2. Second ISS and/or OSS = parking privilege revoked for reminder of the year.
- Substance abuse on campus = parking privilege revoked for one year in addition to Discipline Code Policy.
- Weapon found on student or in vehicle = parking privilege revoked for a least on year and possible permanent revocation in addition to Discipline Code Policy.
- 5. On campus driving misconduct (scratching off, speeding wheelies, etc.) can result in revocation of parking for up to one year.
- 6. Leaving campus without permission will result in parking privilege revoked for a year.
- 7. Transporting another student off campus without authorization will result in revocation of parking privilege for one year
- Failure to register a vehicle with the school or improperly parking a vehicle (such as parking in an unassigned space) can result in not only revocation of parking privileges, but also having your car towed away at your expense.

Parking Consequences for Unexcused Tardies to School

1st Tardy-Warning-student issued a copy of the warning

2nd Tardy-Probation-student issued warning that future tardies will result in loss of parking

3rd **Tardy**-Loss of parking privilege for 5 school days. Student must surrender parking permit hang tag to the Front Office upon check in.

4th Tardy-Loss of parking privilege for 20 school days. Student must surrender parking permit hang tag to the Front Office upon check in.

5th **Tardy**-Loss of parking privilege for remainder of the semester. Student must surrender parking permit hang tag to the Front Office upon check in.

****Any student who parks on campus after a 5th unexcused tardy to school will have his/her car towed at his/her expense without warning.****
